

The Wynfield Homeowners Association (WHOA) takes your privacy seriously. Please read the following to learn more about our privacy policy.

What This Privacy Policy Covers

- This policy covers how WHOA treats personal information that WHOA collects and receives, including information related to your past use of WHOA products and services. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.
- This policy does not apply to the practices of companies that WHOA does not own or control, or to people that WHOA does not employ or manage.

Information Collection and Use

General

- Since you are homeowner in the subdivision, we maintain personal information such as the name(s) of the homeowner(s) and your address, which are publicly available in the mortgage deed records. This information may be combined with information from WHOA member directories published previously, and information provided by WHOA board members, WHOA committee members and other homeowners.
- WHOA collects personal information when you update your profile on the WHOA website and when you visit pages on the WHOA website.
- Within your profile we ask for information such as your birth date, gender, email address, occupation, phone numbers and personal interests.
- WHOA automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, browser type, WHOA cookie information and the page you request.
- WHOA uses information for the following general purposes: fulfill your requests for information, improve our services, contact you, conduct research, and provide anonymous reporting.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

- WHOA does not rent, sell, or share personal information about you with other people or nonaffiliated companies except to provide products or services you've requested, when we have your permission, or under the following circumstances:
 - We respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims;
 - We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of WHOA's terms of use, or as otherwise required by law.
 - We transfer information about you if WHOA operates under the guidance of a management organization. In this event, WHOA will notify you before information about you is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

Cookies

- WHOA may set and access WHOA cookies on your computer.
- WHOA uses cookies to access your information when you "sign in," so that we can provide you with customized content, such as My Yahoo!.
- Estimate and report our total audience size and traffic.

Your Ability to Edit and Delete Your Account Information and Preferences

General

- You can edit your WHOA Profile Information, including your email preferences, at any time.
- We reserve the right to send you certain communications relating to the WHOA, such as emergency announcements and administrative messages, without offering you the opportunity to opt-out of receiving them.
- You can opt out of receiving the WHOA Newsletter and informational emails.

Children

- Homeowners can review, edit, and delete information relating to their child's WHOA profile using the website.

Confidentiality and Security

- We limit access to personal information about you to WHOA board members and committee members who we believe reasonably need to come into contact with that information to provide services to you or in order to do their jobs.
- We provide access to personal information about you to other homeowners and members of WHOA, except for information such as phone numbers and email addresses which you indicate should not be listed.
- We have physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect personal information about you.
- Your WHOA Profile Information is password-protected to prevent unauthorized changes to your profile.
- In certain areas, WHOA uses industry-standard SSL-encryption to protect data transmissions.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

- WHOA may update this policy. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the email address specified in your WHOA profile or by placing a prominent notice on our site.
